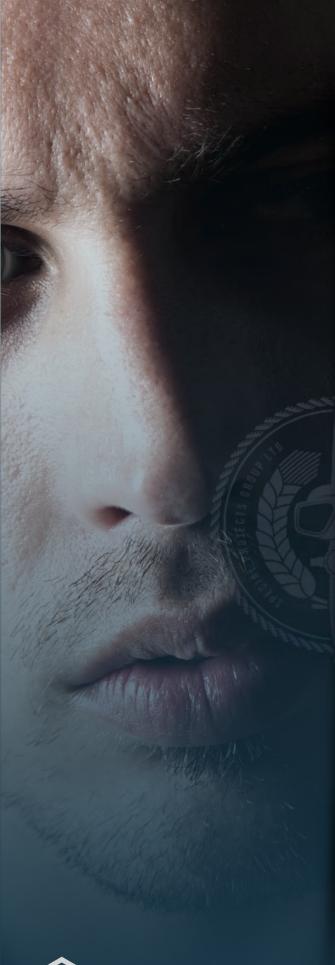
Objectives of the Course
